Appropriate referral includes, but is not restricted to:

- 1. Podiatric surgical cases require the following X-rays prior to referral: WEIGHT BEARING AP, LATERAL, AND OBLIQUE VIEWS
- 2. Diabetic Foot Care:

Currently we are seeing patients classified as level 1 with deformity, callus, pre-ulcer or h/o ulceration, and level 2 or 3 diabetics with active and/or history of ulceration, foot deformities, acute problems.

Risk Level 1: Loss of protective sensation with no weakness with one of the following: deformity, callus, pre-ulcer or h/o ulceration.

Risk Level 2: Loss of protective sensation with weakness with one of the following: deformity, preulcer, callus, h/o ulceration or poor circulation

Risk Level 3: H/O of plantar ulceration or neuropathic fracture.

- 3. Osteomyelitis
- 4. Foot cellulitis/infection
- 5. Foot or nail deformities
- 6. Foot pain
