ZSFG 2019 T2DM ORAL ALGORITHM

Many of you attended the Quarterly Provider meeting in April and heard Dr. Julie Kim's presentation of the ZSFG Diabetes Team's **T2DM Oral Algorithm**, updated from 2013. Since then, we have had more interdisciplinary discussions and integrated the latest data announced at the American Diabetes Association's annual conference in June.

It's an ever-changing landscape, but we are happy to finally synthesize everything into the algorithm, keeping in mind our formulary restrictions. 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Patients with T2DM are often very worried, fearful and resistant to starting insulin. We see this all the time and it's normal.
